I am honoured to present the Chair's report for the 2024 Annual General Meeting of Stoke Prior First School's Parent Teacher Association. This is our first year as Co-chairs and I feel like we have had a hugely successful year. We are a small but mighty team of volunteers, with our main aim being that of raising vital funds for our school to enrich our children's learning experience.
